LETTER FROM THE JUDGE


March 31, 2026

→ **History**

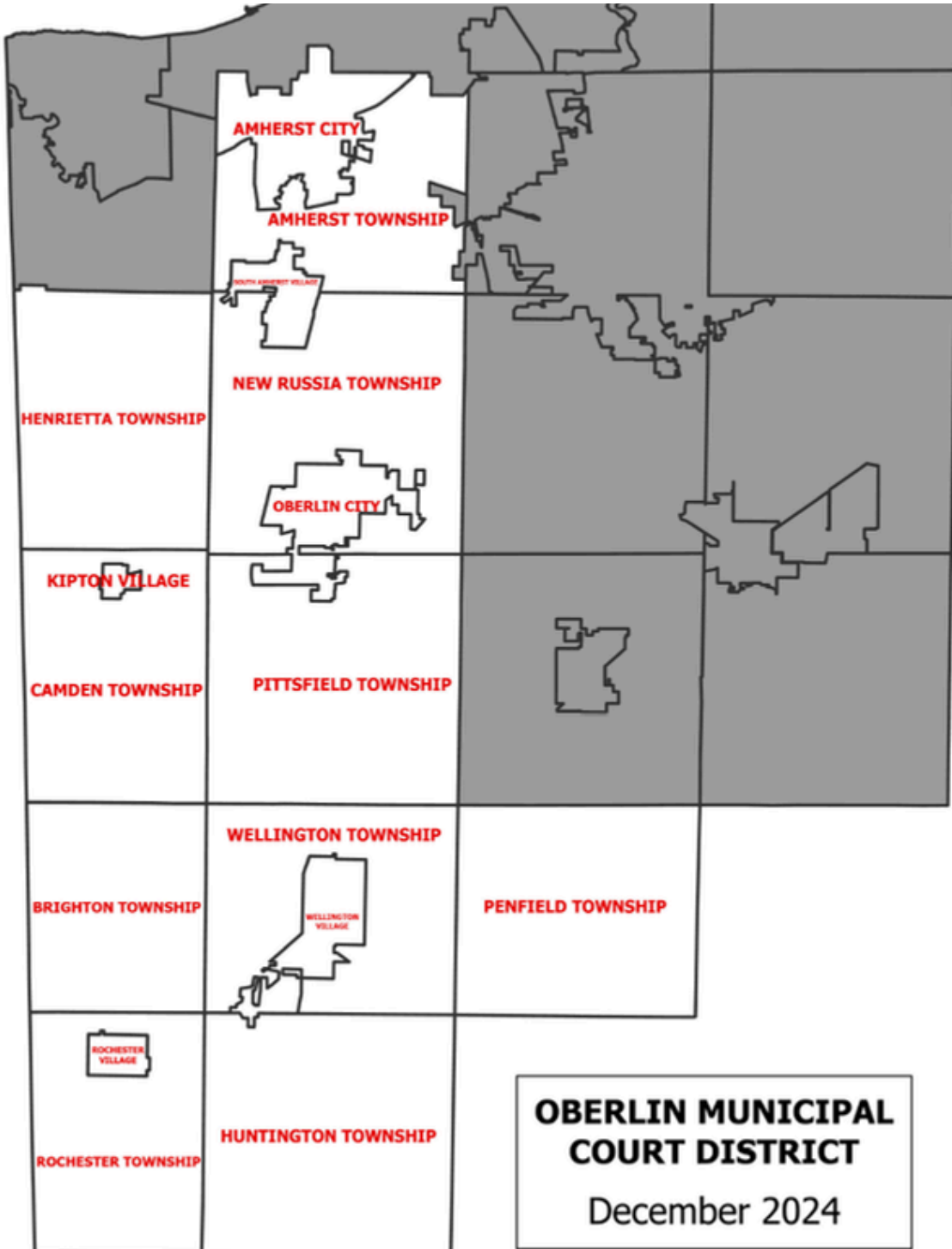
The court was established in 1958. The court is a full-time court with one judge who serves as the administrative and presiding judge. There have been 3 judges of the Oberlin Municipal Court. Judge Goldthorpe served from 1958 to 1975. Judge Martin Heberling served from 1975 to 2001. Judge Thomas Januzzi served from 2001 to 2025. Judge Farah L. Emeka was elected the fourth judge of the court in November of 2025. With her election, Judge Emeka became the first woman, person of color, and resident of the City of Oberlin to serve as judge of the Oberlin Municipal Court.

COURT FINANCES, REVENUES & EXPENDITURES

A court has no funds of its own and it does not function to generate revenue. Court fines, costs and fees help finance the expense of the operation of the court. While the court generates revenue by collecting money, the funds are an incidental benefit to the court's primary function of the administration of justice.

Fines are imposed to correct inappropriate behavior and to maintain a standard of conduct. Both civil and criminal cases include court costs. Fines are limited to traffic and criminal cases and may only be assessed if a person is found guilty of an offense. The court collected overall revenue of \$1,614,182.83 in 2025, an increase from the previous year. Additional funds were dispersed to the City of Oberlin, the City of Amherst, the Village of Wellington, Lorain County, and the State of Ohio, in accordance with the law. Oberlin Municipal Court is audited on a yearly basis by the State of Ohio to ensure compliance.

COURT COSTS

State law requires court costs be assessed in all civil, traffic and criminal cases. These costs help to cover the cost of operating the court. The State of Ohio imposes costs on municipal court cases to support the costs of state sponsored projects. This money supports special revenue projects managed by and for the State of Ohio and is not kept by Oberlin Municipal Court or the City of Oberlin for court operations. The court sets its costs and retains a portion after the balance is transferred to the State of Ohio.

SPECIAL PROJECT COURT FUNDS

The Ohio General Assembly grants statutory authority to municipal courts to create and maintain special funds from court costs. These funds are not included in the operating budget and are controlled solely by the court. The funds allow the court to make improvements and maintain court programs without seeking additional funds from the City of Oberlin. Use of these funds is restricted by law.

The Computer Fund, which is comprised of two accounts—the Clerk's Computerization Fund and the Court's Computerization fund—provides for the installation and upgrade of the court's computer system and related projects. R.C. 1901.261(B). This fund is also used to purchase software upgrades and computer supplies as well as consulting and maintenance contracts. The Clerk's Computerization fund accrued \$11,759.00 in 2025 with a balance at the end of the year of \$66,331.04, and the Court's Computerization fund accrued \$1,306.00 in 2025 with a balance at the end of the year of \$15,31.85.

The Court Improvement Fund accrued \$15,457.78 in 2025 with a balance at the end of the year of \$1,032,643.08. Pursuant to R.C. 1901.26, the court is permitted to use certain funds to pay for special projects of the court including, but not limited to, the rehabilitation of existing facilities, the acquisition or replacement of a bailiff's vehicle. The special projects fund permits the Court to update equipment with no additional funding from the City of Oberlin's general fund.

The Court Supervision Fees (Probation) fund is part of the court's effort to fund the Community Control Department so that it does not become a burden on the general operating fund of the court. The Community Control Department is funded in part through collection of Supervision Fees that are permitted by law. In 2025, the sum of \$38,961.65 was collected for Court Supervision Fees.

Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund (IDAT) money comes from a portion of fines collected in OVI convictions and driver's license reinstatement fees distributed by the Ohio Department of Public Safety for OVI defendants. The fund is restricted to providing alcohol, drug and/or mental health services to indigent defendants. In 2025, the fund collected \$10,046.28 with an ending balance of \$14,937.45. The State of Ohio has given courts more discretion to also use IDAT funds for substance abuse assessments, outpatient, and in-patient treatment programs.

Indigent Drivers Interlock and Alcohol Monitoring Fund (IDAM) is funded by a portion of fines collected for OVI convictions. IDAM collected 11,939.00 and had an ending balance of \$64,543.84 in 2025. This fund is restricted to pay for ignition interlock and other alcohol monitoring devices for indigent defendants. The court has discretion to declare any surplus to be used for other rehabilitative services.

Civil cases arise between private parties, unlike traffic or criminal charges, which originate with the government. Civil cases are usually filed to recoup monetary damages, return property, or restore rental premises in eviction proceedings. The financial maximum for civil cases filed in Oberlin Municipal Court is \$15,000. Civil cases are divided into three (3) sections: general civil cases, small claims, and eviction proceedings. The total number of civil cases filed and reactivated in 2025 decreased by 6 cases from 1,337 in 2024 to 1,331 in 2025. Small claims cases are limited to civil cases involving up to \$6,000.

Landlord/Tenant Cases. New eviction cases in 2025 decreased by 74 cases, to 87 cases in 202 from 161 cases in 2024. The cases include a landlord's claims for possession of rental property as well as claims for damages to the premises and unpaid rent.

COMMUNITY CONTROL DEPARTMENT

The Community Control (Probation) Department is responsible for two primary functions within the court system: presentence investigations and probation supervision. A presentence investigation (PSI) is conducted after the defendant has been convicted through a plea of guilty or a finding of guilt. The defendant is interviewed by a probation officer to provide the court with more background information about the offense and the individual prior to final disposition. The resulting presentence report may include collateral information from family members, the arresting officer and the victim. The Probation Department wrote 74 presentence reports in 2025. When an offense causes property damage or personal injury, the victim is contacted to provide information regarding the offense and is encouraged to express an opinion regarding sentencing. The Probation Department consults with the victim to verify the amount of loss or personal injury and forwards that information to the court so the court may order payment of restitution. A condition of community control supervision regarding a victim may also include a No Contact Order.

The Community Control Department oversees individuals placed on community control supervision. Probationers must comply with a variety of court-imposed conditions to maintain their freedom in the community and avoid the original jail sentence. Terms of community control supervision often contain a strong rehabilitation component to address what initially brought the individual to court. The rehabilitation may include mandatory treatment for alcohol and drug dependency, attendance at twelve step meetings, personal counseling or case management services, completion of a family violence program, mental health treatment or community work service. Individuals are often required to obtain evaluations or assessments and the Community Control Department monitors compliance with the assessment for the benefit of the community at large, the person charged, and their families. The Probation Department uses electronic monitored house arrest and global tracking as an alternative to jail when appropriate. The Oberlin Municipal Court uses this tool as a condition of pretrial bond conditions. The Probation Department makes referrals to ignition interlock services for repeat OVI individuals with driving privileges. Installation of an interlock device requires the driver to blow into a breathalyzer attached to the ignition. The car will not start if the device tests positive for alcohol. Probation officers spend a significant amount of time devoted to case management and preparation for probation violation hearings.

The Community Control Department also has the duty of presenting most probation violations in open court and making recommendations with regard to those violations. Hearings are held in which probationers are required to appear in court on charges of a probation violation. The probation officer informs the individual of the charges and prepares testimony for the court detailing the violation. The court may choose to impose the original sentence or require further probation conditions. Individuals referred to the Probation Department often suffer from a variety of personal problems including substance use disorder, family problems, financial, mental health, homelessness, and medical issues. Probation officers use a variety of community resources to offer individuals assistance in areas of need. The goal is for the individual to successfully return to the community when the probation term expires.

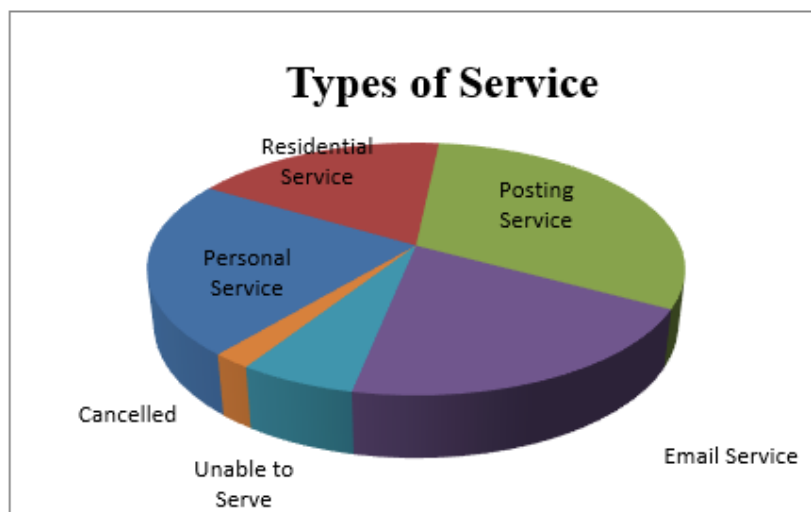
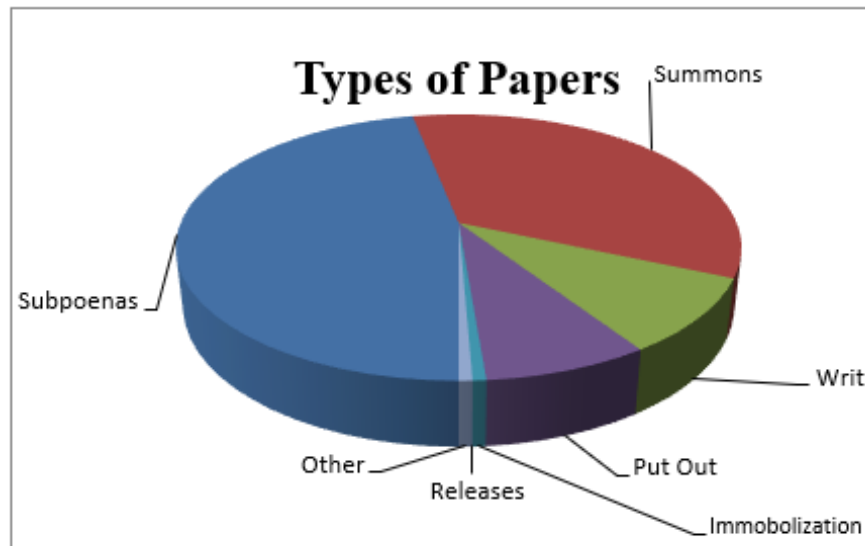
BAILIFF'S REPORT

2025 Year-End Report

The Oberlin Municipal Court employs 1 full time Bailiff, 1 full time Deputy Bailiff, and 2 part time Deputy Bailiffs / Court Officers. They are responsible for the safety and security of the courthouse as well as the Judge, employees, and visitors. This is accomplished by operating and maintaining the metal detector at the main entrance, monitoring, maintenance and upkeep of the CCD and panic alarm systems and the training of employees of emergency procedures. The Deputy Bailiff is assigned to work with the Deputy Clerks in archiving the older court files by scanning them electronically and entering them into the Court's database system.

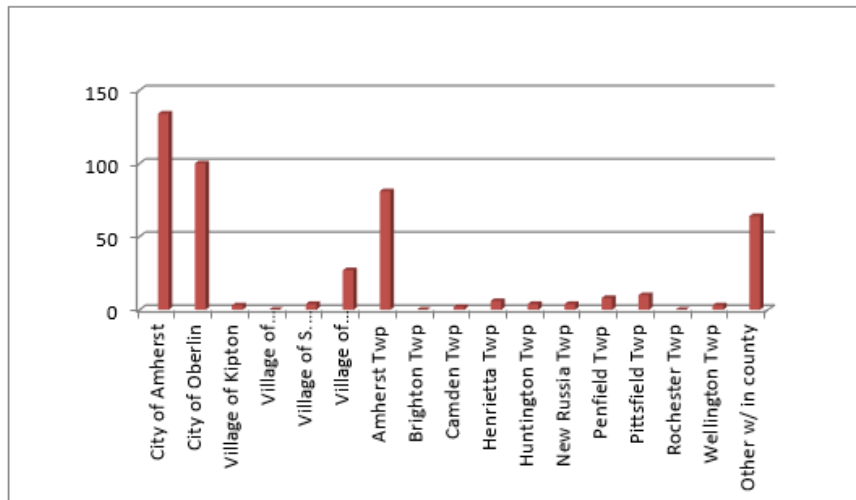
Other responsibilities of the Bailiff include the service of summons, subpoenas, writs and execution of Writ of Restitutions. As of December 31st, 2025, there were 461 court issued papers and orders requiring service to persons within the Lorain County area. The three types of services are Personal Service (102), Residential Service (82), and Posting Service (142). Service requires the Bailiff to contact the person by either personally handing him (or her) the paper to be served (Personal Service), leaving the paper with an adult or other responsible person at the listed address (Residential Service), or posting the paper in a conspicuous place, usually on the front door after unsuccessful personal or residential service (Posting Service). In 36 instances, persons were not able to be served and the results were documented. The most common cause of being unable to make service of any type was contact made at the listed address, but the subject had moved and did not leave a forwarding address. Continuing our efforts to be more efficient by saving time and resources, service to certain persons was accomplished by email. This process involved the Bailiff making contact with the person by phone and verifying their email address. The subpoena would then be scanned and emailed to the person with a request of a return email verifying receipt. This saves the time and resources of the Bailiff by allowing him to stay at the court continuing his duties while making service of papers at the same time. Service by e-mail is viewed favorably by the recipients as being convenient and practical. There were 92 subpoenas that service was made by email, accounting for 28% all of papers served. To accomplish traditional service, a total of 2975 miles were driven and \$3,073.32 in mileage fees and \$210.00 in service fees were charged. The bailiff uses a 2024 Ford Escape Hybrid. This vehicle is in line with the court's commitment to reducing waste and minimizing the carbon footprint.
